Currency in the Republic of Macedonia is Macedonian Denar (MKD). Coins are 1, 2, 5, 10, 50 Denars. Notes are in 10, 50, 100, 500, 1.000, and 2000 denars.

All major currencies may be exchanged, but Euros are easiest to exchange.

1Euro= 61.8 Denars

1GBP= 70 . Denars

1USD= 50,4 Denars

(The exchange rates could vary and they should be used as a guideline).

Credit and debit cards are widely accepted

9. Climate

Macedonia has a transitional climate from Mediterranean to Continental. In May it varies from 15 to 23 degrees Celsius.
