

**2<sup>nd</sup> International Meeting of the Regulatory Authorities and Institutions from SEE  
Responsible for the Implementation and Enforcement of the Directive 2014/53/EU (RED)**

**15 – 16 May 2018, Metropol Hotel  
Ohrid , Republic of Macedonia**

The Regulatory Agency for Electronic Communications (AEC ) is organizing the international meeting on the “Implementation and Enforcement of Directive 2014/53/EU (RED)”. The meeting will be held in May 2018 at the Metropol Hotel in Ohrid.

Bearing in mind that the full implementation of the Directive 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 on the harmonisation of Member States laws related to the making available on the market of radio equipment and repealing Directive 1999/5/EC (RED) started on 13 June 2017, introducing the new regulatory requirements for radio equipment, there is a need to discuss current issues between regulatory authorities, competent national institutions and organizations and the institutions of the European Union, in the context of the following topics:

- 1. The existing legal and institutional frameworks relating to the making available on the market and putting into service of radio equipment in the SEE countries:**
  - The existing regulatory framework and R&TTE market monitoring in the participant countries;
  - Experience in implementation of the framework;
- 2. Cooperation opportunities:**
  - RED ADCO group activities and cooperation means;
  - Cooperation between regulators related to radio equipment;
  - Create a (non)permanent body, at the voluntary basis, for continuous activities and cooperation with ADCO RED;
  - Access to the ICSMS for non EU countries
- 3. Interpretation and clarification of RED provisions**
- 4. RED guide (combined equipment, test equipment, several products within the same packaging)**
- 5. Experiences in the application of RED**
- 6. Any other business**
- 7. Closing of the meeting**

We expect that the representatives of the regulatory agencies, ministries, state institutions and organizations, as well as the representatives and experts from EU institutions responsible for regulating this particular field, will take part in the Meeting and contribute to its success and quality.

### **City of Ohrid**

Ohrid is a city in the Republic of Macedonia and the seat of Ohrid Municipality. It is the largest city on Lake Ohrid and the eight-largest city in the country, with over 42,000 inhabitants as of 2002. Ohrid is notable for once having had 365 churches, one for each day of the year, and has been referred to as a "Jerusalem (of the Balkans)". The city is rich in picturesque houses and monuments, and tourism is predominant. It is located southwest of Skopje, west of Resen and Bitola. In 1979 and in 1980 respectively, Ohrid and Lake Ohrid were accepted as Cultural and Natural World Heritage Sites by UNESCO. Ohrid is one of only 28 sites that are part of UNESCO's World Heritage that are Cultural as well as Natural sites
